Dear Gentlemen:

This is to confirm that, after due consideration, the Department of Public Works has determined that Klingie Road, N.W. from east of Courtland Place to west of the entrance to Klingie Heights, will remain closed. The area of closure will be rebuilt as a recreational area, and all existing drainage related damage and deficiencies in the Klingie Valley watershed will be corrected.

The referenced portion of Klingie Road has been closed to vehicular traffic for nearly five years. During that time, some marginal increase in traffic has been noted on Porter Street, but the increase cannot be related to the Klingie Road closure.

It must be noted that, given the District's financial situation, it is unlikely that any rehabilitative work will be accomplished on Klingie Road for some time. The process will begin soon, however, to identify an appropriate design for the recreational concept, and necessary funding, including Federal Highway Administration participation.

As these elements of the restoration of the Klingie Valley watershed are developed, the interested community will be notified. Your continued interest and support are appreciated.
