RE: Klingle Road

Dear Mr. King:

At this Commission's January 23, 1995 regular monthly meeting, we once again discussed the proposed reconstruction of Klingle Road, N.W. between Rock Creek Park and Woodley Road. We have continued to delay responding to community concerns and providing our recommendations to DPW while we await promised information. Accordingly, the following resolution was adopted by unanimous vote of the Commission (all present).

WHEREAS: Local residents are concerned about traffic problems in the immediate vicinity of the intersection of Porter Street and Connecticut Avenue, N.W. as well as Klingle Road and the environmental degradation of Klingle Valley;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: **That ANC 3-C urges the Department of Public Works to expeditiously complete its reassessment;** respond to citizen concerns about congestion on Porter Street and Connecticut Avenue, Klingle Road, and the environmental degradation of Klingle Valley; provide the results of its ongoing traffic study; and make its recommendations about the project so that ANC 3-C may act on this matter at its meeting on February 27th, 1995.

As you can see, our concerns relate to both traffic and environmental impacts. We hope very much that DPW will be able to help us before we [again] act at our next meeting, scheduled for February 27th.
