Residents of Lanier Place expressed concerns regarding overflow traffic since the Klingle closure. Police also supported reopening Klingle. Captain Manning urged open roads enhance police operations and emergency preparedness. Many of these scenarios involve transporting personnel and equipment across wards and through the city. Eliminating roads restricts logistical options.
